Power Up Academy is a job training program designed to build a pipeline of technical talent for a diverse and equitable clean energy economy. Participants will learn the entry-level skills needed to become design techs, coordinators, and analysts.

Program Components

The energy sector needs more entry-level designers, engineers and project coordinators. These positions play a critical role in the construction of new and existing electricity systems that enable reliable energy grids. As a part of this program, you will receive:

- Industry Knowledge: Develop a basic understanding of the electrical industry and how these roles support a clean energy future. Participants will have the opportunity to learn from and engage with a coalition of engineering companies.
- Spatial Aptitude: Develop the ability to read, draw and scale objects.
- **Computer Skills:** Develop the basic excel and AutoCAD skills needed to plan projects, budgets and draw schematics.
- 21st Century and Job Preparation Skills: Develop the problem solving, testing skills, and organizational and other life skills needed to be successful in these roles.
- **Job Preparation Skills:** Develop cover letters and resumes and receive placement support from the workforce agency partner.

Enrollment Requirements

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have a high school diploma or GED equivalent
- Have a valid driver's license
- Pass screening tests
- Pass admission interview
- Strong computer skills

Graduates will receive a certificate and prepare for industry-recognized testing.
