



NON-HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE CERTIFICATION

To: All Gardner Denver Nash Customers, Distributors, and Representatives:

Effective March 1, 2006, Gardner Denver Nash implemented a policy that requires a **NON-HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE CERTIFICATE** to be completed and received prior to equipment being sent to **any** Gardner Denver Facility for evaluation, modification, service or repair.

This policy has been implemented to ensure the health and safety of both our employees and all others who may come in contact with the equipment. While a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) that describes the material with which equipment has come into contact during its use may also be required prior to equipment being sent to any Gardner Denver facility for evaluation, modification, service or repair; the information provided on the SDS does not necessarily assure that the equipment is safe to handle. **Therefore, Gardner Denver Nash will only accept equipment that has been certified as being FREE from all contaminating materials that are commonly recognized as Environmental, Safety, or Health Hazards**, and most notably those defined by OSHA Regulation 29 CFR 1910.1200. Gardner Denver Nash feels confident that you will support the implementation of this policy in a unified effort to ensure the health and safety of all personnel who may come in contact with the equipment.

Attached you will find a copy of the Gardner Denver Nash "**NON-HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE CERTIFICATE**". Completion and submission of this properly signed document must be received prior to the product being shipped to any Gardner Denver Nash facility to certify that the equipment being received is free of these hazards.

Gardner Denver Nash vacuum pumps and compressors, and Hoffman & Lamson blowers received with properly executed Non-Hazardous Substance Certification will be promptly processed. Equipment received without certification will be held for a maximum of 30 days. Gardner Denver Nash will send one request for correct documentation to the customer, agent or distributor. No processing will be performed on any equipment pending receipt of required documentation. If proper documentation is not received within 30 days, customer will be requested to pick up his equipment or arrange, as consignor, return freight to his facility.



TO: GARDNER DENVER NASH CUSTOMERS

To allow Gardner Denver Nash to maintain compliance with federal, state and local environmental and safety regulations, including the OSHA Regulations on Hazard Communication (29CFR 1910.1200), Gardner Denver Nash requires that all equipment received at any of its facilities for evaluation, modification, service, and/or repair be free of any generally recognized Environmental, Safety or Health hazards. To facilitate this requirement, a completed copy of this "**NON-HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE CERTIFICATE**" declaring the equipment to be free of these hazards and Safety Data Sheet (SDS) if **necessary; MUST** be received prior to the equipment being accepted at any of our facilities. Failure to provide the certification and SDS if required will result in notification that your equipment cannot be processed without required documentation. If proper documentation is not received within 30 days, customers will be requested to pick up his equipment or arrange, as consignor, return freight to his facility.

The owner/operator of the equipment will be responsible for any cost associated with cleaning up any release of petroleum products or chemicals that were in the equipment or injury to Gardner Denver employee(s) caused by such release.
