On this page, you'll find a complete breakdown of your energy charges, including usage information over the past year. We also provide the latest supply price for supplier comparisons, gas supplier charges and details (if not supplied by BGE), and a list of convenient ways to pay your BGE bill.

1 Electric/Gas Supply

is based on market prices and the amount of electricity or gas that you use. When the cost of electricity or gas increases, so will the total of your bill—even if you use the same amount of electricity or gas as the previous period.

- **Electric Supply** – price per kWh adjusts three times a year, reflecting market conditions
- **Gas Supply** – price per therm varies each month, determined by the gas commodity market
- **BGE DOES NOT PROFIT WHEN THE COST OF ELECTRICITY OR GAS INCREASES**

If you choose to get your electricity or gas from a third-party supplier, then the supply costs are based on your contract with that provider. For more details on BGE supply pricing, refer to section "6".

2 BGE Electric/Gas Delivery

covers the cost of delivering energy to your home or business, maintaining or enhancing the power grid, and ensuring safe and reliable service.

3 Customer Charge

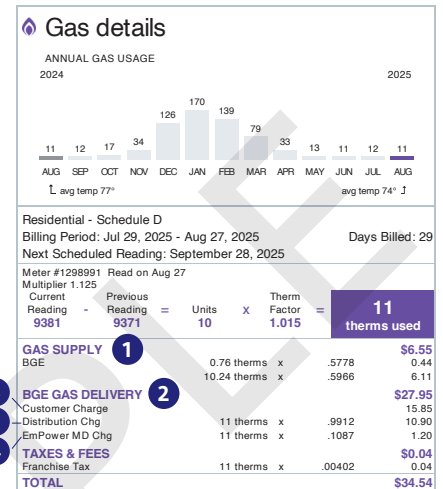
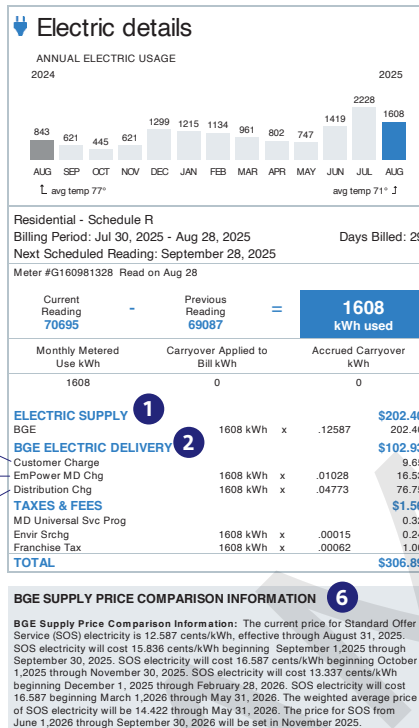
is a fixed fee that covers meters, meter reading, and customer service costs incurred by BGE.

4 EmPOWER MD Charge

funds state-mandated energy efficiency programs designed to help reduce greenhouse gas emissions. BGE does not earn a return on this charge.

5 Distribution Charge

is a variable cost that pays for the work BGE does to ensure safe and reliable service. BGE does not earn a return for the customer charge, approved by the MD Public Service Commission.
