

Formulaires et renseignements clés requis lors d'un déménagement aux É.-U.

Points importants à retenir avant de commencer

- Votre déménagement est de type « marchandises à venir ». Cela signifie que la douane américaine exige que vous et votre groupe soyez déjà aux É.-U. au moment où votre conteneur franchira la frontière.
- Tous les conteneurs sont susceptibles d'être inspectés par la douane américaine. En cas d'inspection aléatoire, le cadenas du conteneur sera enlevé et remplacé par un nouveau, aux frais du titulaire du compte. Le titulaire du compte doit également s'acquitter des frais occasionnés par l'inspection.
- Vos biens sont assujettis à une imposition des droits et taxes par la douane américaine. Cette transaction intervient entre vous et la douane américaine; cela ne concerne PODS en aucun cas.
- L'échéancier est sujet à changement. Malgré nos efforts pour que votre déplacement transfrontalier se déroule le plus harmonieusement possible, veuillez noter qu'un retard pourrait survenir. Nous vous invitons à faire preuve de patience et nous communiquerons immédiatement avec vous en cas de retard.
- Vous devez soumettre tous les documents requis à PODS avant de pouvoir planifier le transport de votre conteneur. **Veuillez noter que tous les services prévus à l'horaire dépendront de la disponibilité actuelle.**

Étape 1

Étape 2

To make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title, make entry or collect drawback, and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement, supplemental statement, schedule, supplemental schedule, certificate of delivery, certificate of manufacture, certificate of manufacture and delivery, abstract of manufacturing records, declaration of proprietor on drawback entry, declaration of exporter on drawback entry, or any other affidavit or document which may be required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such bill of lading, sworn statement, schedule, certificate, abstract, declaration, or other affidavit or document is intended for filing in any customs district;

To sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback, or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unloading or navigation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds

which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable Laws and regulations, consignee's and consignor's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended or affidavits in connection with the entry of merchandise.

To sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the lading, clearing, lading, unloading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor;

To authorize other Customs Brokers to act as grantor's agent; to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in grantor's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; if the grantor is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of process on behalf of the grantor;

And generally to transact at the customshouses in any district, any and all customs business, including making, signing, and filing of protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, in which said grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney, giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents:
