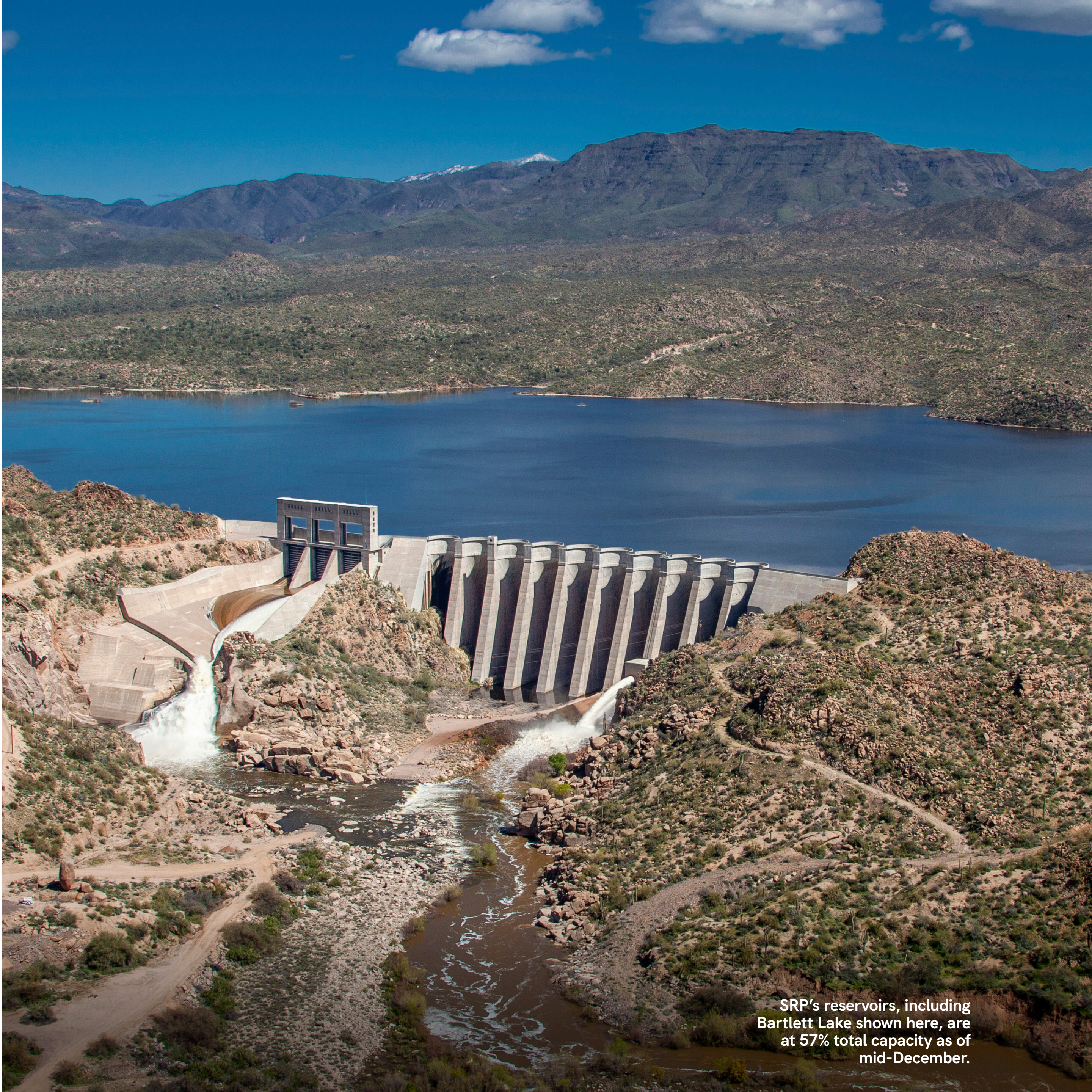

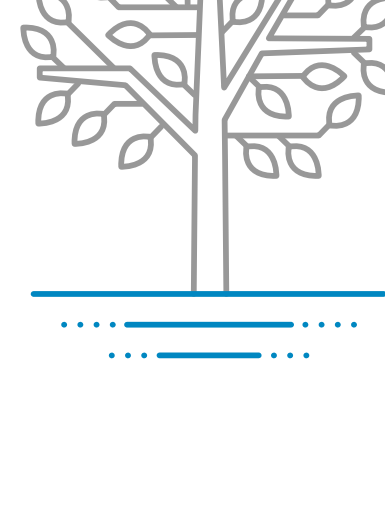
IMPORTANT REMINDER: irrigation payments due

All bills for excess water received in 2025 must be paid by Feb. 23 to avoid an interruption of irrigation service. Any water received beyond the amount shareholders have paid for is considered excess water. Property grading plays a crucial role in enhancing the efficiency of flood irrigation. By shaping the land to create a uniform slope, grading ensures that water flows evenly across the property.

Stay safe along canal trails

Understanding normal flow water rights

Established by the Kent Decree in 1910, normal flow (NF) water rights apply to lands cultivated between 1869 and 1909. Water is delivered in eight-day cycles, with entitlements based on priority dates. To earn NF credits, customers must run water during the designated period. Credits must be used within the same year. SRP offers both standard and NF-only accounts, each with specific guidelines. SRP encourages customers with NF entitlements to understand their rights to ensure efficient water use.

Annual water use filing

Each year, shareholders with grandfathered irrigation rights are legally required to report the type and quantity of irrigation water used on their land to the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR).

Soon, SRP will send shareholders a summary of their 2025 water usage, including the amount of groundwater and surface water delivered to their property.
